Watershed 101 is designed to guide members of the Evergreen High School, Junior Watershed Managers (JwM) club, through a series of techniques appropriate for developing a watershed monitoring program. The watershed 101 class will draw from the Bear Creek Association's 30-years of watershed management to summarize the principles of water quality management, wastewater use, fisheries, macroinvertebrates, nutrient management and urban runoff pollutants. Furthermore, there will be a collaborative brainstorming session that will conclude with identifying a relevant "on-the-ground" project to improve water quality and watershed health.
